Meeting of the Jefferson County Pilots Association, 3 November 2007.

Meeting convened by Pres. Pat Shannon at 1001 with the announcement that the meeting would be cut short in order to permit members to attend memorial services for Judy Miller, wife of member Don Miller, who had recently passed away.

Introduction of guest Ian McFall, glider pilot and representative of the Economic Development Council, who made himself available after the meeting to discuss needs of the airport community.

Several prior meetings had been informal (fly-outs, barbeques and the like). Notes memorializing those "meetings" were presented for ratification as the formal minutes of this association. Moved, seconded and passed that they be adopted as the official minutes of the association.

**Treasurer's Report:** Cash on hand, \$1,572.95; value of Certificate of Deposit, \$2,790.27 with YTD interest of \$85.60.

There was no old business.

**New Business:** Moved, seconded and passed, that reasonable reimbursement be given Port Townsend Aircraft Services to compensate our hosts for refreshments so graciously provided at our meetings. Moved, seconded and passed, an amendment to the foregoing to specify the amount at \$60 per year.
