MINUTES OF THE MAY MEETING

The monthly meeting of the Jefferson County Pilots' Association was called to order on 1 May 2010, at the pilots' lounge of

Port Townsend Aircraft Service. In the absence of both the President and Vice-

President of the Association, Dave Ward, chairman and the Fly-In committee, volunteered to chair the meeting.

Old Business:

The meeting was devoted almost entirely to planning for the upcoming Fly-In. Planning

meetings, open to all members, will be held on alternate Fridays, at 1000 at the pilot lounge of Port Townsend Aircraft Service, beginning 14 May. Meetings have been held with the Port representatives to discuss the

Fly-In. Agreements were reached whereby the Port will:

- (1) be a co-sponsor of the event;
- (2) allow use of Port "dumpsters" and provide additional receptacles as required;
- (3) provide "Porta-Pottis";
- (4) waive tie-down fees during the event;
- (5) permit camping by visitors;
- (6) advertise the event on the Port web-site; and
- (7) mow and tidy up the grounds just prior to the Fly-in.

JCPA will be responsible for clean-up. The issue of liability insurance is unresolved: the Association is responsible for procuring insurance, but the Port may kick in a few bucks.

Dave, Gail and Ari could use help. Any reasonable suggestions will be welcomed.

New Business:

There was no new business, except an announcement that Jim Llewellyn and two others are seeking a fourth partner to purchase (Tailspin) Tommy Wacker's Cessna 172. He may be contacted at (206) 842-4552 or (206) 450-0101. The asking price (total, not partnership share) is said to be \$38,000.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the meeting was adjourned just before noon.
